REPORTING ABSENCES

- child's name
- date of birth
- postcode
- symptoms/asymptomatic
- date symptoms started
- date of the test result.

Due to the current circumstances, can parents/carers please ensure they are signed up to Class Dojo. This will ensure the school can remain in constant communication with you in case your child's bubble or the school is required to isolate. Please remember more than one parent can sign up to be connected to the same child. BREAKFAST AND AFTER SCHOOL CLUB (OUT OF HOURS)

From Monday 8 March, Breakfast Club will continue and After School Club will resume. Please complete the online form the week before to ensure your child has a place. If possible, pay online. Mr Hartley will provide the necessary details. If you are still in arrears for fees, we would be grateful if you could settle the amount owed. If you owe money, it could result in your child losing their place. Any monies owed will be credited to your account. Cost for Breakfast club - before 8.00 am = £3, after 8.00 am = £2.00 and after school = £7.00 per day.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Please put suntan lotion on your child during sunny days before school. Children can bring suntan lotion to school if they have sensitive skin and they will be supervised re applying it. Please ensure it is clearly labelled with their name and put into a bag with a note from yourselves giving permission for it to be re applied. Jelly shoes, sliders and open toed sandals should not be worn for school. The children are running round during playtimes and sometimes the field is a bit damp. Long hair should be tied back and nail varnish should not be worn to school.
