#### **FIRST CONFESSIONS AND FIRST HOLY COMMUNIONS**

#### **READING BOOKS AND READING RECORDS**

Now that we are allowing books to be taken home and brought back each day, please try to encourage your child to read every day and then sign the reading record for them, even if they read an online book. It is very important that the children read every day, especially because of the interruptions to learning they have faced in the last fourteen months.

#### **ASSERTIVE MENTORING**

Mrs Burns recently reintroduced Assertive Mentoring (HAM) in Mathematics to help the catch up and she said that the children deserve a round of applause for their effort. They have all been trying really hard so well done, everyone. Keep up the good work.

#### **CHILDREN'S BELONGINGS**

Please remember to label all items of your child's belongings to make it easy to identify any that go missing. Please check any clothing that you may have labelled at the beginning of the year in case the label has worn off or fallen off. Thank you.

#### **REPORTING ABSENCES**

Please contact school before 8.45 am if your child is going to be absent. If your child receives a positive COVID-19 test result, please inform school immediately by telephone, email or Dojo. If it is outside of school hours, please email:

- child's name
- date of birth
- postcode
- symptoms/asymptomatic
- date symptoms started
- date of the test result.

.Due to the current circumstances, can parents/carers please ensure they are signed up to Class Dojo. This will ensure the school can remain in constant communication with you in case your child's bubble or the school is required to isolate. Please remember more than one parent can sign up to be connected to the same child. ### **PE KIT**

The school PE tracksuit is available at Laser Schoolwear, our uniform supplier, in County Road at a cost of £20 for the tracksuit bottoms and hooded, zipped jacket. Otherwise, it is navy shorts and white round necked t shirt. Please follow school rules and do not send your child to school in other bright coloured, named sportswear. ### **FIDGET TOYS/LOOM BANDS**

Please do not let your child bring in either fidget toys or loom bands. Any child in school that has been identified as having a need for fidget toys are provided with them by Mrs Perry. Thank you.

### **BREAKFAST AND AFTER SCHOOL CLUB (OUT OF HOURS)**

If you need your child to attend Breakfast Club and/or After School Club, please complete the online form the week before to ensure your child has a place. If possible, pay online. Mr Hartley will provide the necessary details. If you are still in arrears for fees, we would be grateful if you could settle the amount owed. If you owe money, it could result in your child losing their place. Any monies owed will be credited to your account. Cost for Breakfast club - before 8.00 am = £3, after 8.00 am = £2.00 and after school = £7.00 per day.

### **HEALTH AND SAFETY**

Please put suntan lotion on your child during sunny days before school. Children can bring suntan lotion to school if they have sensitive skin and they will be supervised re applying it. Please ensure it is clearly labelled with their name and put into a bag with a note from yourselves giving permission for it to be re applied. Jelly shoes, sliders and open toed sandals should not be worn for school. The children are running round during playtimes and sometimes the field is a bit damp. Long hair should be tied back and nail varnish should not be worn to school.
